



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Mason Technology is committed to doing business in an environmentally responsible manner. We actively take care of the environment and ensure that our business is conducted in compliance with the applicable laws. As an ISO 9001:2008 company, our Quality Statement specifically refers to our Environmental Strategy.

Mason Technology continuously strives to reduce consumption of key input parameters and reduce emissions in all areas. In recognition of the importance we hold for the environment, the position is managed by the P.A. to the CEO, who is the dedicated Environmental Officer and is responsible for the:

- Proactive monitoring of environmental impacts.
- Ensuring compliance with the relevant environmental legislation and regulations.
- Actively promoting environmental awareness among our staff.

Specific responsibilities for the Environmental Office would include but not limited to:

- Evaluation of low emissions vehicles for sales and service.
- The administration of WEEE legislation for the disposal of electrical goods.
- Registered member for the disposal of Radioactive Material.
- The safe storage and disposal of chemicals and reagents.
- Implementation of low energy lighting.
- Staff education and use of paper bins for recycling.
- Safe disposal of waste oil.
- Identifying opportunities for the reuse of cardboard boxes for the shipping of parts etc.
- Implementation of a cardboard compactor, to reducing recycling pick-ups.
- Purchasing of A++ energy efficient appliances.
- Safe disposal of Spent Batteries.

The Environmental Officer is supported by the Quality Manager and Quality System (ISO 9001:2008). As a non-manufacturer, but distributor and supplier of Scientific Equipment we work closely with our suppliers and regularly audit (ISO 9001:2008) and review their environmental policies.

The vast majority of our suppliers have policies in place to reduce Emissions and Energy consumption, such as:

- GreenPak TM and SpaceSaver TM programs by Mettler Toledo.
- Green Procurements Standards from Shimadzu.
- Reducing Green House Emission Gas's by half, a strategic objective by the Olympus Corporation.
- Edwards Vacuum Working to SEMI, ITRS & S23 guidelines.
- Eppendorf epGreen policy.

All our suppliers are compliant with RoHS, REACH and WEEE legislation. Individual Environmental Policy statements are available per suppliers on request.

Mason Technology is constantly striving to reduce energy usage and has recently introduced virtual servers to our I.T. network, eliminating the number of servers in use.
