Is my current software obsolete?

The following softwares are obsolete and we recommend updating to a new platform:

- All Olympus "Analysis" packages- Supported upto Windows 2000
- All Olympus "Cell" packages Supported upto Windows 7 32bit only
- Olympus Stream packages supported in Windows 7 platform.

Why should I update or upgrade my microscopy software?

Software should be updated to prevent security risks, fix bugs and keep up with new devices and operating systems.

Depending on the age of the hardware in use, upgrading your current software could be transformative. With a range of benefits, including:

- Compatibility with Windows 11
- Improved speed of operation
- Increased speed and resolution if camera is upgraded.
- Improved functionality for stitching images in XY and Z
- Ease of support from local team in Mason and Evident international helpdesk
- Training for staff to ensure that the system is used to the maximum extent possible.

Why should I upgrade my microscopy software?

The current software running in Windows 7 can be updated and upgraded with some free upgrades while older versions and upgrades to a new platform could have a cost. Check your serial number on <u>here</u> to see what is available if you have "Stream", "Cellsens" or PreciV software.
